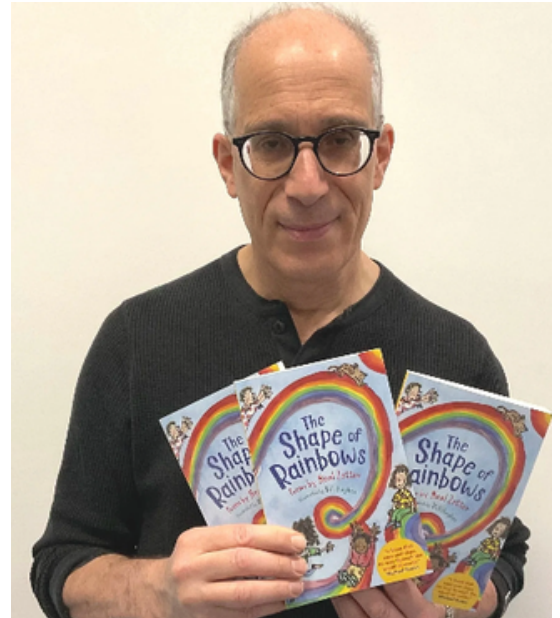


Neal Zetter will be visiting Grange again!
