increase hands-on—'active' learning at Grange.

Just today, I observed a fabulous Year 1 Maths lesson in the playground with children using chalk and immersing themselves in the learning. Our music lessons are also restarting and Year 6 had their first violin lesson of the year and I am so excited to join in with them as they embark on a wonderful year of violin learning which will culminate in their performance at the year 6 graduation in July 2026.

He commented that the children appeared so confident and happy. 
