Grange Primary's First Sponsored Walk – A Stride Towards Safer Streets

On Wednesday 11th June 2025, Grange
Primary School held its first-ever Sponsored
Walk in support of *Brake.org*, the road safety
charity. The event brought together Year 6
pupils and Student Council representatives in
a meaningful community initiative to promote
road safety awareness and raise funds for a
vital cause.



The walk began at 1:30pm, starting from the Welbeck Road entrance of the school. Pupils followed a carefully planned route, passing through local roads including Coles Crescent, Rayners Lane, Roxeth Green Avenue, and Shaftesbury Circle, before looping past Whitmore High School and West Harrow Park, and finally returning to school via Furness Road.
