If there is not enough interest for that club to be viable, your payment will be refunded.

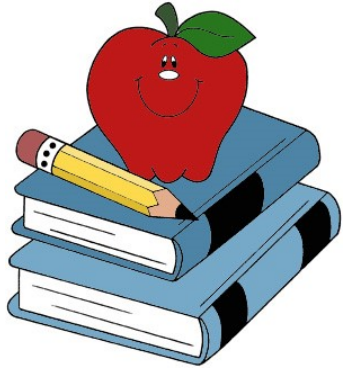
We hope that the children have lots of fun and learn new skills.

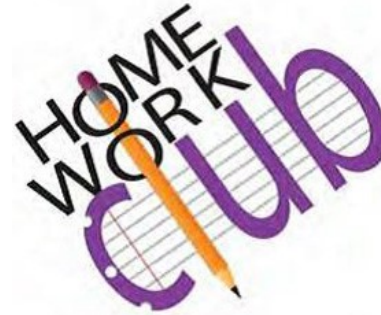

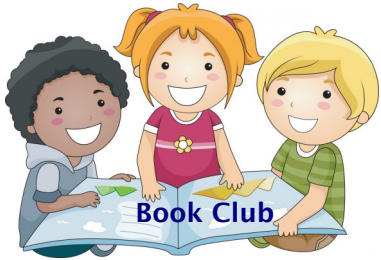

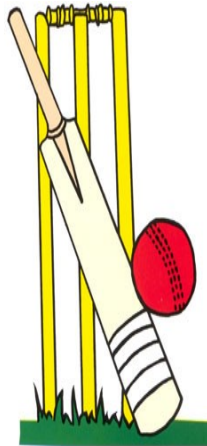
Cricket Club
