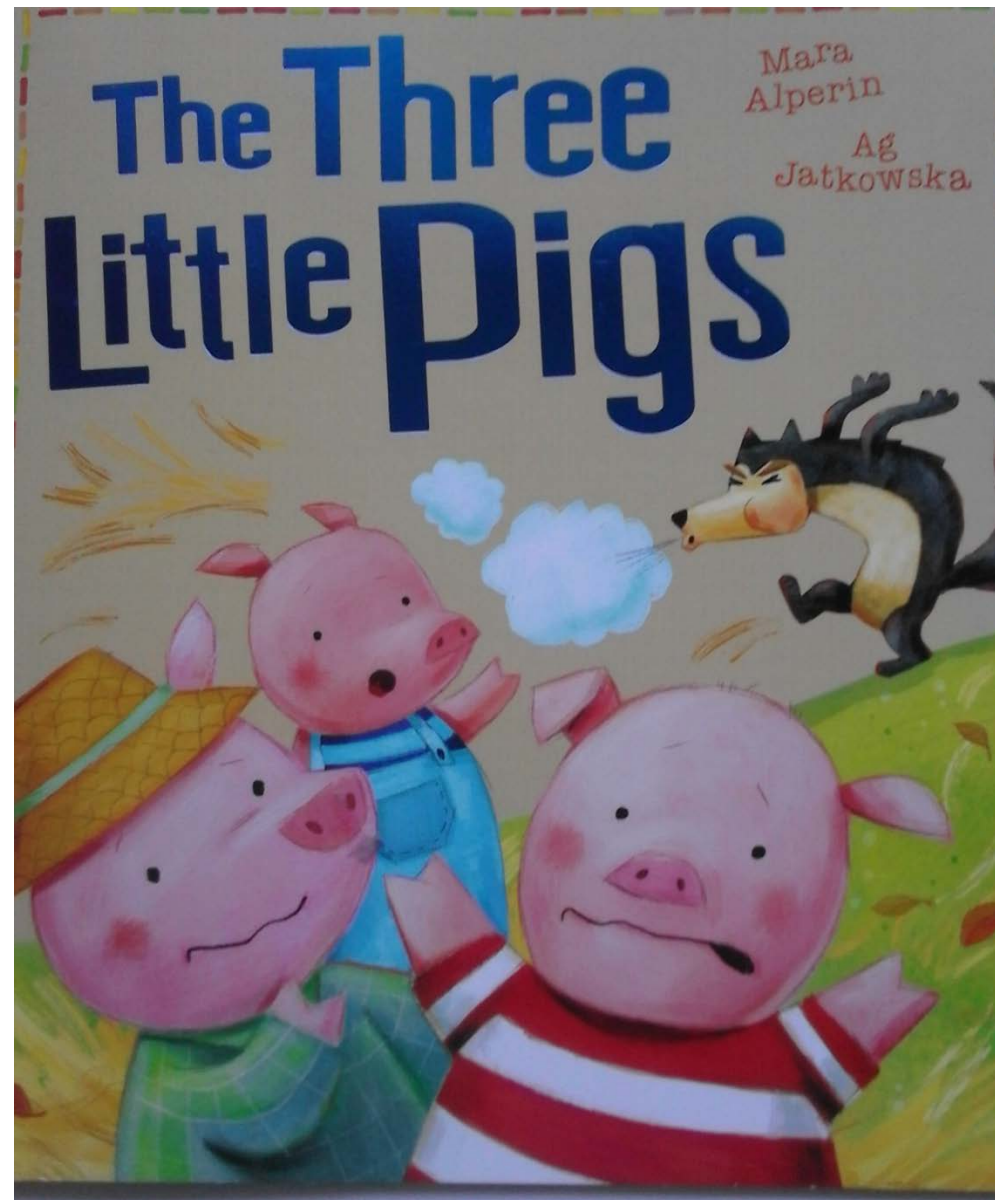


Part 1
