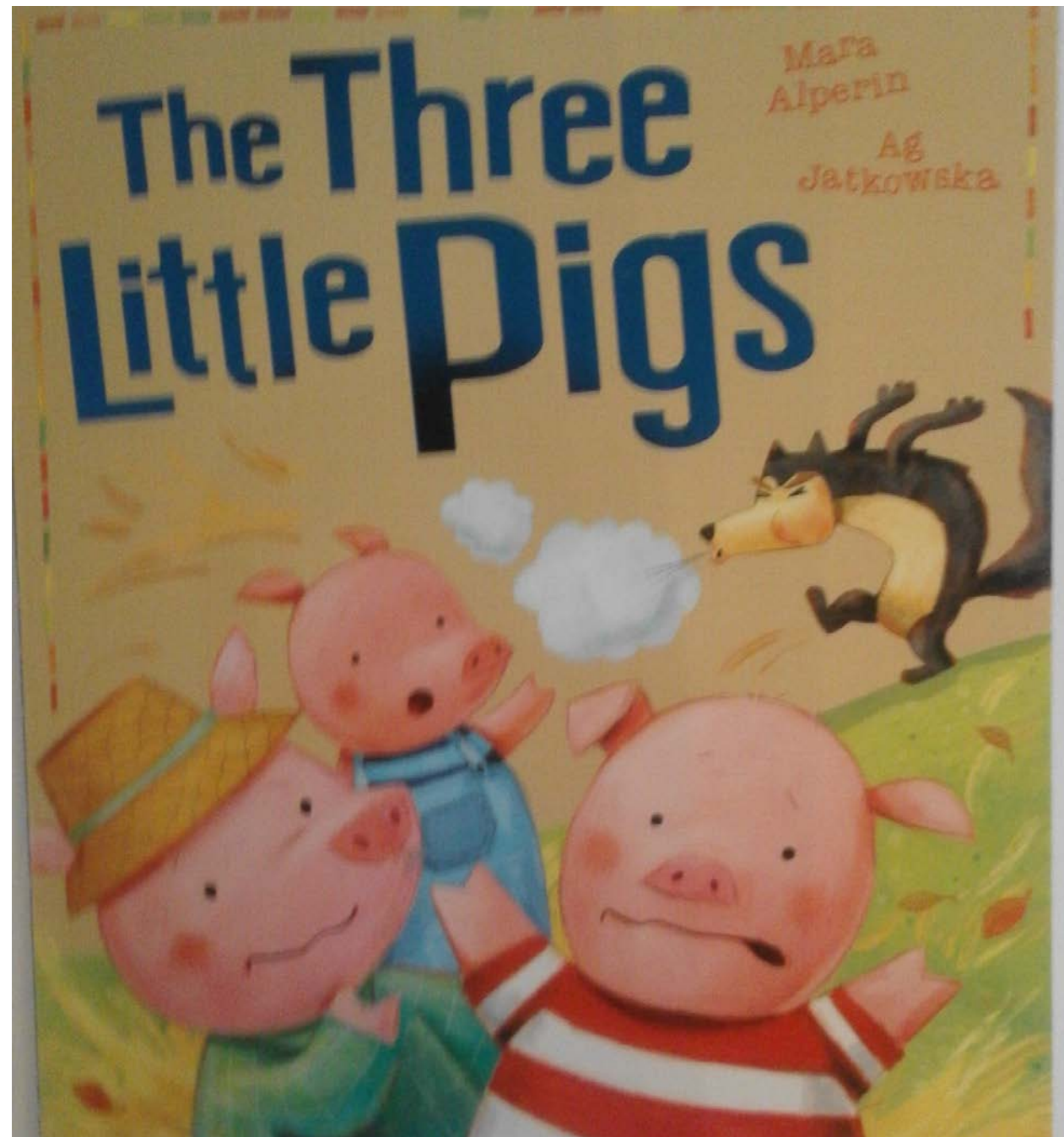


Part 2

And **crash!** Boris's house clattered down.. down...**DOWN!**



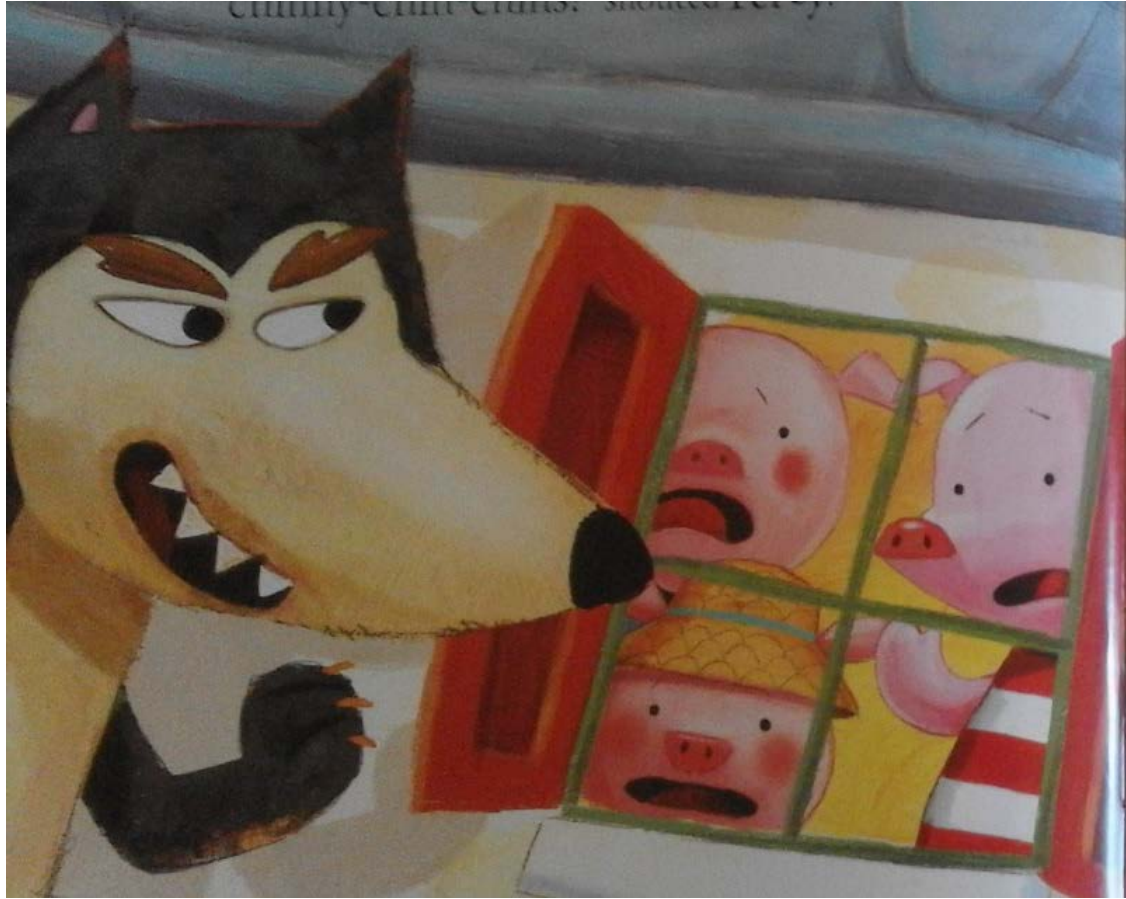
Horace and Boris squealed and galloped all the way to Percy's house of bricks.
