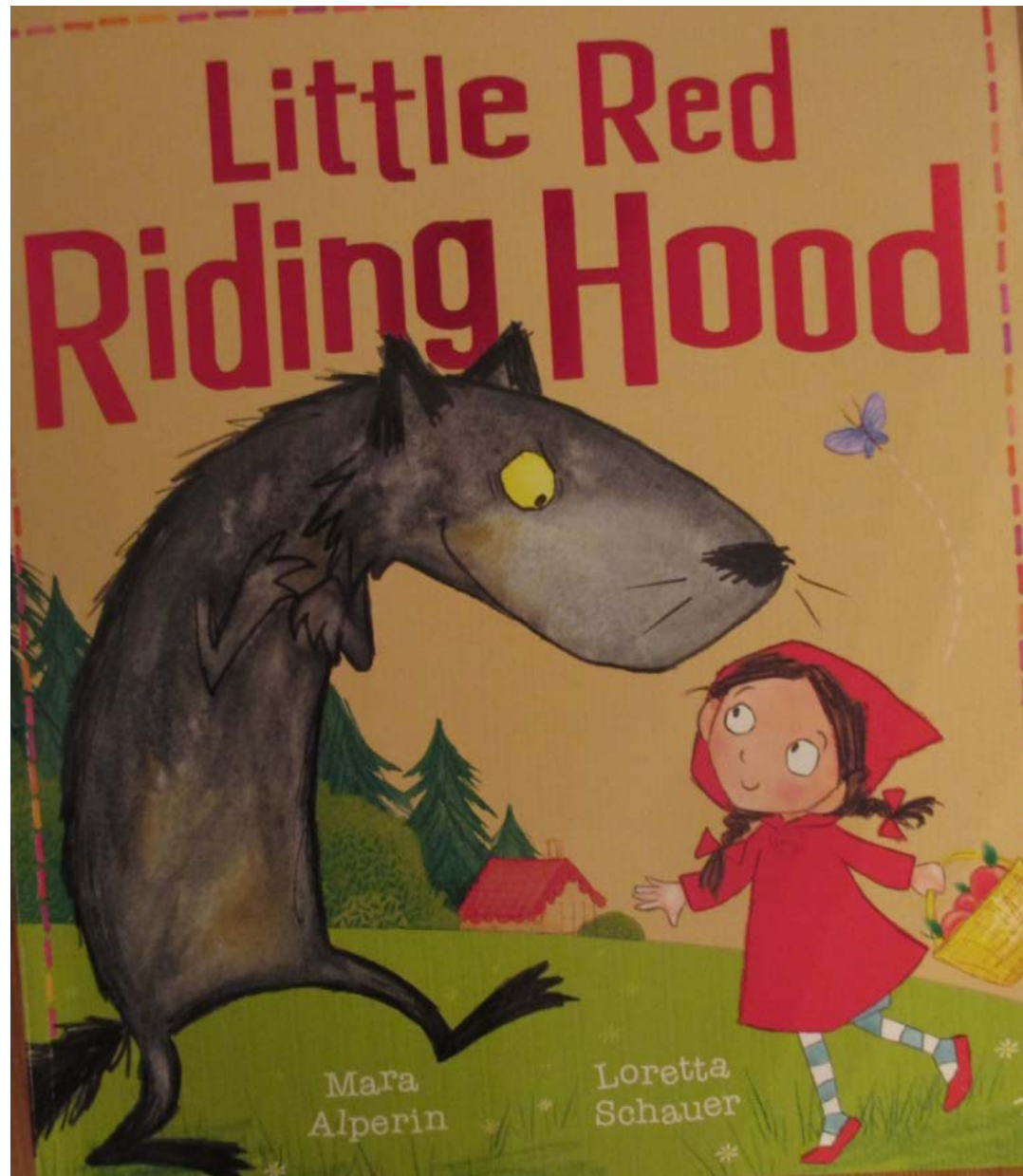

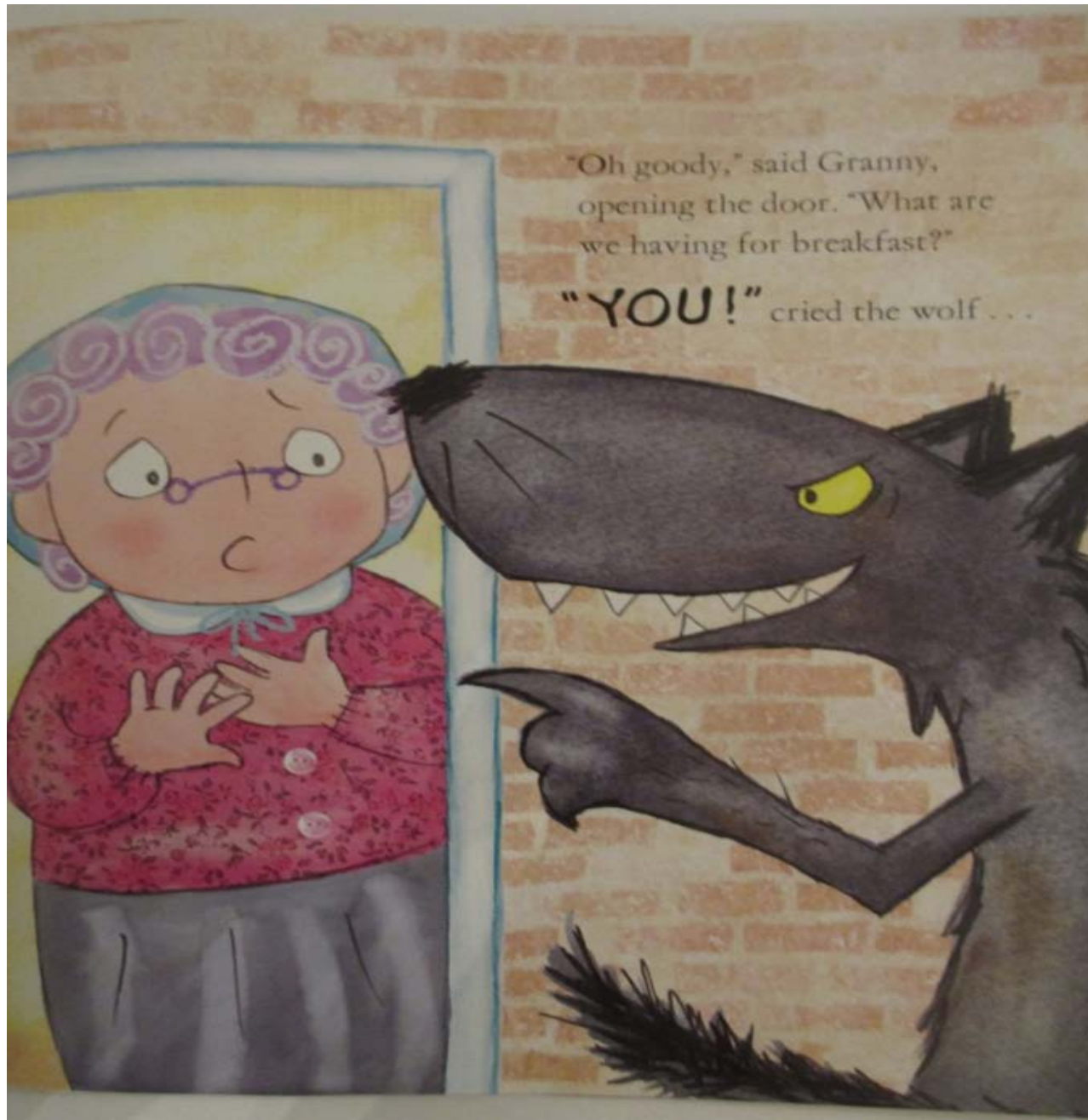


The wolf knocked on Granny's door with a **thud! thud! thud!**

So when **Little Red** knocked tap! tap! tap! on Granny's door, it was a deep, scratchy voice that answered, "Come in, my dear."

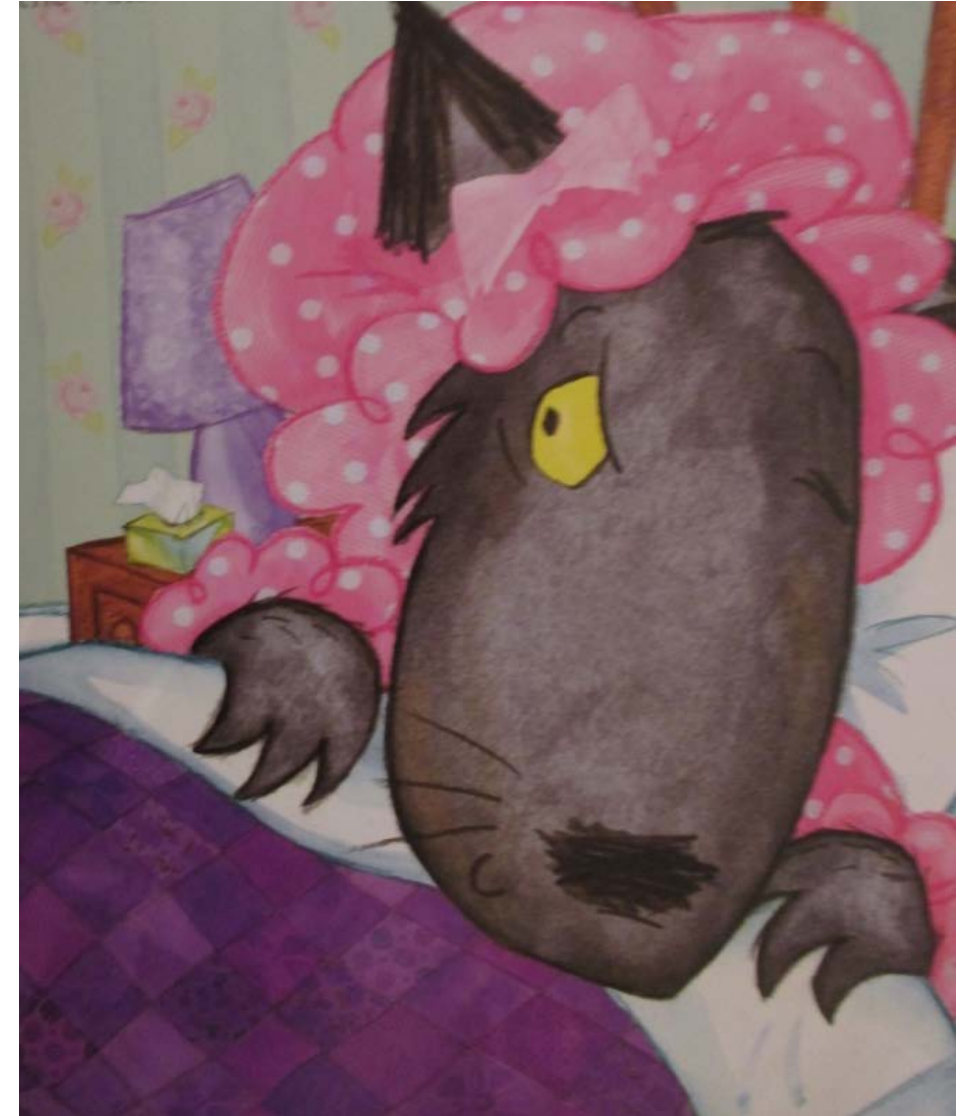


Little Red walked into Granny's bedroom and stopped in surprise. "Why Granny!" she said slowly.
