The Big Picture

For this half term we will be working through the story 'Evie in the Jungle' by Matt Haig, which is available as a FREE e-book download on a Kindle or via the FREE Kindle app (the app works on phones, laptops, tablets and computers).

We will be developing the following reading skills: comprehension, inference, prediction, summarising, dictionary skills, using knowledge of prefixes and suffixes to approach new vocabulary (linked to grammar work) and selecting appropriate examples to support answers.

We will take a layered approach to learning, cycling through each of the skills on rotation depending on the source material (which chapter of the book we are reading).

Enquiry Questions

- What do you know, from evidence in the story?
- What do you think?
- What parts of the story inform your thinking?
- How can you use knowledge of prefixes and suffixes to help you understand new words?
- What are the most important parts of this chapter?
- What do you think will happen next? Why?

Key Vocabulary		
Comprehension	Understanding what has been read.	
Retrieval	Finding information from a text.	
Prediction	Saying what will happen next, based on information in the text.	
Inference	Using the clues provided to grasp the meaning of the text without being given all the information.	
Deduction	Using evidence in a text to support an idea.	
Summary	A brief recollection or account of the main points of a piece of writing, action or event.
