


LI: I know who the Anglo-Saxons were.

The Anglo-Saxons arrived in England in AD 450




Who were the Anglo-Saxons?




A group of people that became known as the Anglo-Saxons attacked Britain. They were from several different tribes. Mainly, they were Saxons, Angles and Jutes. The Anglo-Saxons came from Northern Germany, Holland and Denmark. They arrived in AD 410.

Why did the Anglo-Saxons invade? Anglo-Saxon settlements and kingdoms



When the Romans left, Britain became an easy target, as there was no regular army to protect the people. The invading Anglo-Saxons sent word back that Britain was rich in land and perfect for crops and raising animals. As their own lands were often flooded and unsuitable for growing crops and farming animals, many Anglo-Saxons invaded to find a better life.



They came across in groups of longboats, bringing their own tools and animals. Each group of people built their own settlements and had their own leader.
