As I am sure you know, a new national lockdown is starting tomorrow. School will stay open as usual with the same staggered start and finish times.

To keep everyone as safe as possible, we would like to ask you to do the following things:

<p><u>Wear a mask</u> when you are coming to school, inside and outside the school gates</p>	
<p><u>Social distance</u> when you are coming to school, inside and outside the school gates</p>	
<p>Let your child walk in the gate by themselves if they are old enough</p>	
<p><u>Lunch boxes</u> should not be sent in to school</p> <p>Bring lunches in something that can be thrown in the bin</p>	

<p><u>Water bottles</u> only come to school on Monday and go home on Friday. We will wash and refill them every day with fresh bottled water.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>MONDAY ONLY</u></p> 
<p><u>Do not send your child to school if they have:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New continuous cough, and/or • High temperature, and/or • A loss, or change, in your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia) <p>Call 111 and get a test as soon as possible.</p>
