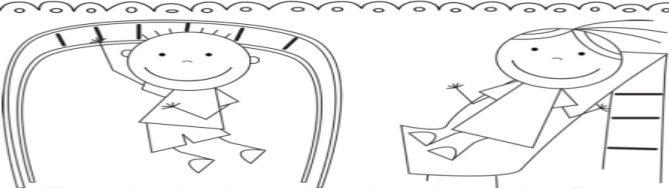
Jigsaw - Being Me in My World

Key Vocabulary

Belonging	To feel comfortable and happy in an environment.
Calm	A quiet and peaceful state.
Consequences	A result of a particular action or situation, often one that is not good or convenient.
Proud	Feeling pleased, satisfied and worthy because of something one owns or has done.
Responsibility	Having an expectation to do something.
Rewards	To give something in return for an achievement.
Rights	Something you should expect to have automatically e.g. a right to come to school.
Safe	Free or secure from harm or danger.
Special	Something or someone who is important and unique.
Valued	Useful and important.
