The Big Picture

'Lost and Found' is a story about a boy and a penguin who showed up at his door. The boy works hard to find out where the penguin came from and how he can get the penguin home. We will read the story and think about the different feelings the boy and the penguin (two main characters) may experience at various points. We will also think about adjectives to use to describe the penguin and the other characters involved as well as the setting of the story. The children will create their own new main character and re-write the story in their own words. They will also practise writing non-fiction instructions on how to pack a suitcase for a journey.

Enquiry Question

What are feelings?
 What different feelings can you name?
 How do you think the penguin feels at the beginning/middle/end of the story?
 What are adjectives?
 What adjectives can you use to describe the different animals?
 What is the setting of this story? Does it change?
 What does non-fiction mean?
 What are instructions?

Feeling	Different ways we feel inside. They never stay the same and can change for different reasons.
Setting	Where the story happens.
Non-fiction	Writing about real-life things, including lots of information.
