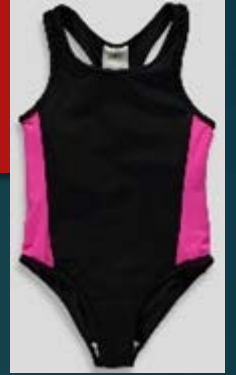
# P.E. Kit

## Year 4 MTC

- In the month of June, the year 4 children will be assessed on their times tables up to 12. This is called MTC (Multiplication Times Check)
- Children will be practising their times tables everyday in class where they will work on fast maths grids, missing number, division and so on to familiarise themselves with their times tables.
- To make this process easy going for the children, it would be highly recommended that children log into TTRS everyday at home to practise their times tables.
